A LOCAL LAW amending Article V and Article XI of Chapter 298 of the Code of the Town of Southampton.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Southampton.

Section 1. Legislative purpose.

The New York State Legislature has enacted new, higher income limits for the senior citizen and disabled persons tax exemption. The purpose of this legislation is to amend the Code of the Town of Southampton to be consistent with State Law by providing, to the full extent, of the benefit allowable under the state law to senior citizens and disabled persons with limited income. These limits are granted pursuant to Section 467 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law.
